 - Assisted Rides in conversation with Uber and LYFT for ride handoff.
 - Assisted Rides can keep track of Uber/LYFT ride and monitors billing.
 - Changing insurance if there is a ride handoff could be problematic.
 - Uber/LYFT no human interface, not convenient for seniors.
 - Assisted Rides program roll out for office staff first. Next time volunteer logs in they will be directed to version 2.
- 5. ANNOUNCEMENTS:** (Kelley, Interim Chair/all)
 - Doherty – Area Agency on Aging terminated contract with Cloverdale Senior Center due to challenges in meeting service delivery units. Will continue to serve Cloverdale area with next round of Caltrans funding with different agency/program model.

- Grant – Healdsburg is close to launching transportation packet for City Council to review and approve on May 7. To include: Subsidized transportation on route 67 and volunteer driver program utilizing city vehicles not personal vehicles. City of Healdsburg is written into Caltrans 5310 grant program for FY 2018-2020.
